Reposado

According to "NOM-006-SCFI-2005, in accordance with the 1977 General Declaration of Protection of the Appellation of Origin of "Tequila" and Article 40 Section XV of the Federal Law on Metrology and Standardization" (Say that three times really fast, I dare you!!), reposado tequila must be "rested" from two months up to a year in oak barrels. This can lend notes of vanilla, pepper, and orange peel along with that beautiful color. Given that old bourbon barrels are usually used, it's not surprising that this is the tequila whisky-drinkers often fall for.

That extra contact with the wood can bring out flavors of caramel, cinnamon, and almond, and a mouth-coating body that edges towards cognac. No need for a lime after this.

The ur-tequila. When alcoholic Spanish conquistadors started running out of brandy, they began distilling a sacred, fermented agave-based drink the natives called pulque, and mezcal was born. Made from many varieties of agave, traditional mezcal preparation involves roasting the "piñas" (the hearts of the agave) in stone pits covered in dirt, which lends it its distinctive smokey flavor. Mezcal is divisive: you'll either love it or hate it. But there's only one way to know for sure.
